1. Assignments and Projects:


- Assignments and projects are more extended assessments that require students to apply their knowledge and skills to a specific task or problem.

2. Presentations by the Students:

- They promote communication skills, public speaking, and the ability to convey complex information effectively.
- Presentation topics can relate to course content, research projects, or personal experiences.
- Students should be given guidelines on presentation length, format, and evaluation criteria.
- Presentations may include visual aids such as slides or multimedia to enhance understanding.
- Peer evaluation can be used to assess presentation quality, encouraging constructive feedback and engagement.
- Presentations can also foster a sense of ownership and pride in one's work.

3. Organizing Quizzes:

- Quizzes are short, focused assessments typically used to evaluate a student's understanding of specific course material.
- They were organized at various points during the course, such as at the end of a unit or as periodic assessments.
- Quizzes often consist of multiple-choice questions, true/false questions, or short-answer questions.
- They provide a quick way to gauge student comprehension, reinforce learning, and identify areas where students may need additional support.
- Timed quizzes were used to assess time management and test-taking skills.
