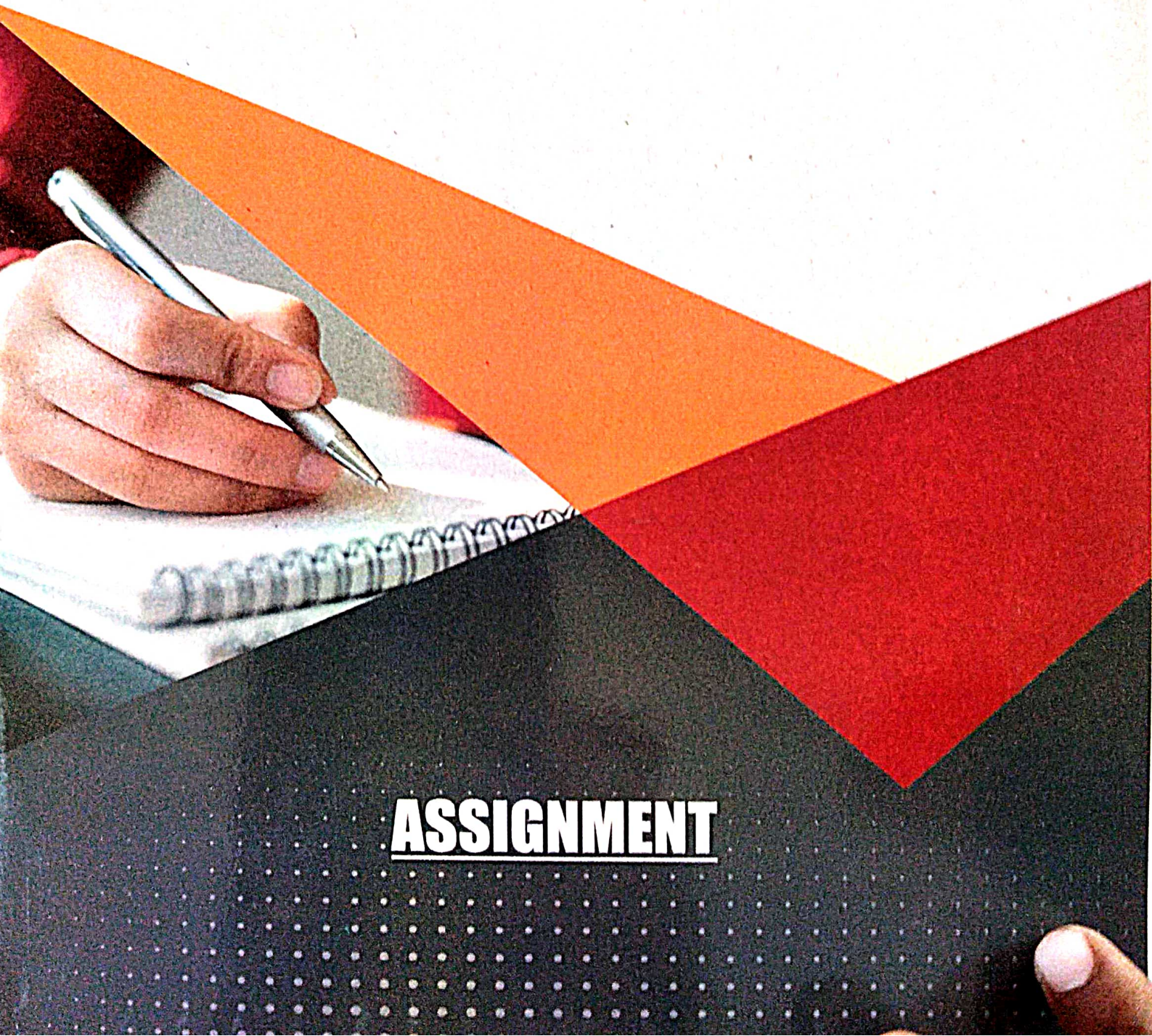

what is meant by furniture arrangement in different rooms.

The arrangement of furniture in different rooms can be explained through the following points.

1. Living room :-

To make the living room organized and decorated, sofa set, table - chair for reading and write, glass cupboards for keeping books, rack, corner table, wooden sofa, etc.

Should be arrangement that from these there should be 7-8 comfortable chairs. along with this, accessorizing like table-lamp, music system, etc. should also be arrangement. Chair should be light but strong. The colour of the furniture should be light, which does not get dirty easily. If the furniture is designer, their wotams, cushions, carpets, rugs, etc. should be used.

2. Bedroom room :-

There should be bed, stool, coat, etc. should be used for

cooper arrangement in the bedroom. Beds should be proper size and height. The bed should be placed against the wall or in the middle. There should be a table at the. If boxes are made in the bed, they can be used to keep bedding, quilts, blankets and other household items. There should be a table lamp near the bed so that there is convenience in reading and writing. There should be one or two chairs in the bedroom for reading and writing and a table with drawers for reading and there is shortage of space a dressing table is arranged in the bedroom itself. Big boxes can also be joined together to give them the space of a bed.

3. Children's room furniture :-

In children's room should be arranged according to their age. In the room of older children, table and chairs should be arranged for reading and writing. The table should have drawers, hook for hanging clothes and a mirror. There should be a table near the mirror on which comb, oil, powder and other beauty products should be kept. The

The reading table should be near the window so that natural scenes can be seen. There should also be arrangement of a bed or cot for sleeping.

4 Dining room:-

If the dining room is arranged in the indian style, then Asam, Chowki, Takhat, Peda Etc. can be used. Asam should be clean and beautiful. Chowki and Takhat should be covered with beautiful and attractive cloth. A big table is required for arranging in the foreign style. There are armless chairs around the table. If the number of family members is more, then the number of chairs can be increased. The dining table should be placed in the middle of the room or near the window so that natural light is received while eating. Beautiful wooden or glass cupboard of cutlery, crockery, dishes, eating utensils.

5. Kitchen room:-

To make the kitchen work simple, easy and convenient, there should be meshed cupboards, high stools, planks, stools or pedestals. If the kitchen work is being done still sitting down, then there.

should be a steel or plank, so that the washed utensils can be kept on them. Cupboards should be arranged to keep utensils. And things whose doors should be properly closed are made for storing things. Platforms are made for keeping utensils. Kitchen furniture should be such that it is easy to clean.

2) Reuse:-

- 1) when buying fruits and vegetables from the market use home made cloth or paper bags instead of plastic bags.
- 2) meals and snacks should not be picked in aluminium foil or paper containers.

- 4) The culture of 'eat and throw' should not be given importance in keeping with culture the materialistic.
- 5) use newsprint and not plastic to cover books.

6) make useful things from material that kids no longer needs.
